



Teaching Leaders is a charity that addresses educational disadvantage by growing a movement of outstanding middle leaders in schools in challenging contexts across England. We do this by offering three leadership development programmes to our schools: TL Fellows (secondary only), TL Primary and TL Teams.

TL in 150 words:

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TL Fellows is our flagship two-year programme where we select and develop a national network of high-potential middle leaders. Fellows receive intensive coaching, training and support, to lead their teams with confidence and transform pupil achievement in their areas of responsibility.

TL Primary is our flagship primary programme. The first year focuses on whole-school impact with groups of middle leaders and the second year develops and deepens system leadership skills.

TL Teams programmes (including NPQML) are in-school modular programmes for both phases, which drive team collaboration to ensure a consistent quality of leadership across the school.
