Using Pupil Voice to Remove Barriers to Learning

Who is it for?

What are the benefits?

This programme is aimed at introducing or developing the use of pupil voice and structured conversations. The programme offers a series of 6 sessions across the year which will explore how staff can identify what they really need to be asking and how they can use the information gained to improve outcomes for pupils.

Underpinning the programme are some fundamental concepts about developing trusting and honest communications between staff and pupils.

Previous delegates have found that they have gained significant insight into what pupils really think about a range of issues affecting their learning and this has resulted in them becoming more reflective practitioners.
